Saturday, March 30, 2024

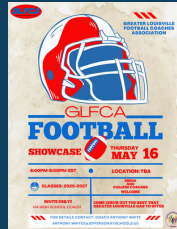
The annual showcases, which are held at various locations in Kentucky and will feature 300+ student-athletes from around the country.
